News flash May-June 2022



Dear friends,

We have a lot to be very grateful for. Both personal as well as Ministry wise.

So many from literally all continents, Thailand, India, the USA, Holland, Singapore, South Korea and South Africa responded to the news we shared in our past couple of news flashes concerning the bad health situation of our son, that was really so serious that we almost had to let him go.

As a family we are so touched by the fact that so many of you prayed for him and have overloaded us with continuing encouraging emails and chat messages, Skype sessions and even telephone calls. And we are so happy, that by all your love, prayers and involvement, we today can tell you that the Lord has intervened as only He can do, and gave our son a new lease of life and that he is doing well again.



The same gratitude goes to all of you, from all the countries mentioned above, that so loyally for many, many years already stand next to us in our Ministry and how we as a family by His calling and under the guidance of the Holy Spirit are running our Baan Zion home and

village project in Chiangrai, this next all the other things that the Lord gives our hands to do.



Your ongoing prayers are daily felt and your financial or whatever other support for our Ministry is indispensable. The fact that all of you share our Ministry vision and idea's, seen from the many positive reactions we constantly receive, for us, our team and the girls mean a lot and are of great encouragement. We absolutely feel greatly blessed in having so many very special, loving and loyal people standing beside us.

Girls

Holiday this year for our girls was different again, since as I wrote last time most



venues we normally use to go to were still closed or asked for an injection qr. But now in special, since one of our staff and later two more girls tested positive for covid. One of my staff had a sort of cold, which is normal during this time of year, but she being afraid of what it could be felt obligated to get tested. And even though none of them had specific symptoms apart from a snotty nose, we as a Foundation/NGO do have a compulsory notification obligation towards the government. This also from a safety aspect since we for our work go to many Hill Tribe villages and contact many people.



The result was, that those that tested positive had to go to the hospital to be extra checked, found apart from a snotty nose to be a-symptomatic, but anyway got loads of very expensive medication after which they had to quarantine in Baan Zion. The house was again completely sealed of, and no one could go out or come in.

The other girls had to move out of the house and we had to put up quarantine camp in a none finished house of an

acquaintance, that was on the slope of a mountain without electricity and or running water. But with lots of snakes and scorpions. My oldest daughter and senior staff, Wan, was the lifeline in getting food, water and whatever needed to both locations.



In all, this quarantine and being on two locations took several weeks. During these 3 weeks constant testing for all was compulsory, being constantly checked by the local health services and our complete house, both inside and out by the health department was treated with some sort of disinfecting spray. We praise the Lord that no one was really sick and whatever minor snotty nose complaints there were, have been touched and healed by the hand of Jesus after praying for them and anointing them with oil. Being back home of course for all of us was of great joy and certainly for those that had to live so primitively for 3 weeks on end. The house was cleaned again, the garden tended to and life now came back to normal.

Growing, breeding and more



Da, our "garden expert", could continue with her fruit, herbs and veggie project and extended her fish and crayfish breeding for which she has developed her own aquaponics system. It is really amazing how well all this is going and we



really look forward to the moment the Lord provides in the funding needed for our self-sufficiency project so we can start growing and breeding on a larger and professional scale and work on the vision the Lord has given us for this.

School and University

A good thing is that last week elementary school and High School finally after 2 years opened up again and in-class studies have started again. Of course, with the here still very stringent in place social distancing rules and compulsory face masks. But of course before going to school again, for all of the girls, including those in our village project, we had to buy their 4 new



school and sport uniforms and corresponding shoes, plus all the other extra compulsory study materials.

The latter, buying the so needed study materials is something that during each school year for all girls will continue since none of this is provided by school. Also, on the 6th of June the University has opened up again and college classes are starting up for our students. One of our new Uni students of course for her studies needed a note book and it is a blessing that we could buy her one.



Village girls

All girls and their grandmothers in the villages are doing well. Also these girls have been confronted with school closures for the last two years, and they did not have the luxury of online study possibilities, but finally also their schools have opened. But very important is that none of them nor anyone in their surroundings have been sick. We as you know in March and April took in 5 more girls, but are still looking for them to being sponsored for 30Euro's / \$32.50 a month. When these 5 girls will be sponsored we budget wise can rescue 5 more girls and bring them under our care and provide them with a future. Then they also will have good food, clothing, healthcare when needed and above all the opportunity to go to school that future wise will offer them a future in breaking free from the endless cycle of poverty and abuse in their village of origin. This next to by our regular checks protection against abuse and human trafficking.

Many girls in need are on our waiting list and in desperate need of our help.



On behalf of our family, our staff, all the girls both in our house and in the villages and each and every one we are reaching with the life changing and healing Gospel of Jesus, we want to thank you for being partners in our Ministry.
